

## **KQHDA – INTERNATIONAL HOMOEOPATHIC CONFERENCE 2017**

A three day International Homoeopathic Conference was organized by Karnataka Qualified Homoeopathic Doctor's Association (KQHDA) for the first time in Bengaluru, from 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> of September at NIMHANS Convention Center, Bengaluru.

In the inauguration address, Chairman of the conference, Prof. Dr B D Patel expressed the need for all the diverse schools of Homoeopathy to work towards common goal, which is 'to serve humanity'. Complimenting PM Modi's statement 'Sab Ka Saath Sab ka Vikas', he gave a slogan 'Sab ka Swasthya homoeopathy ke saath'. He advised to make homoeopathy as a first choice of treatment rather than last resort as it helps to prevent diseases from progressing and builds up immunity. He also expressed his views on the need to encourage Homoeopathy to increase its outreach.

The conference was inaugurated by Shri K R Ramesh Kumar, Minister for Health and Family welfare, Government of Karnataka. He agreed to extend his support in opening up of Ayush Clinics including homoeopathic centres in as many as 176 taluks.

Chief Guest of the Inaugural function, Sh. Shripad Yesso Naik, Honourable Minister of AYUSH, Govt. of India said that Govt. of India has created an admirable infrastructure for the providing high quality education, patient care, undertaking research and ensuring availability of quality medicines. He stated that the NABH guidelines for Homoeopathic Hospitals are notified for ensuring quality services in the care of patients and Pharmacopoeias are being updated to ensure quality production of medicines. Funds are also being provided to State Governments under National AYUSH Mission for propagation and increased accessibility of Homoeopathy through integration of services. He was pleased to announce the national and international collaborations of the Council with the reputed Institutes. He emphasized that the linkages established with about eight internationally renowned organizations in UK, USA, Argentina, Canada, Armenia, Mexico, Germany and Brazil are done with an aim to encourage joint research projects, exchange of information, documentation and scientific publications, Joint conferences and exchange of experts for training of practitioners, scientists, teachers and students. He concluded the speech by applauding the lineup infrastructural developments undertaken by the Council to propagate research be it the new building of Agartala or the virology lab to be inaugurated in Kolkata.

Dr. Anurudh Verma, Member, Central Council of Homoeopathy opined that the stipend for internees should be extended to private college students also as they are serving the people too. He stressed the need to have more number of dispensaries. He also proposed that the participation of Homoeopathic Doctors in national health programmes should be included.

Dr. Raj K. Manchanda, Director General, Central Council of Research in Homoeopathy inaugurated the Scientific session. He explained the entire method, scope and opportunities in the field of Research and encouraged all Homoeopaths to take up the research projects and promised to extend support from CCRH.

Dr. Rammeshwar Rao Garu was given Exemplary Award for starting JIMS Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, a state of art institute at Hyderabad and for his contribution to the field of

Homoeopathy. While accepting the award, he talked about the State of the art homoeopathic college JIMS, at Hyderabad.
